Bright, textural, and refreshing, this Fiano is full of notes of ripe nectarine, toasted almonds, and a bright, saline minerality, finishing with a streak of lemon acidity.

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LONGAVÍ 2020 “GLUP” PAIS, BIO BIO VALLEY, CHILE

Pais is a varietal with quite a long history and this particular wine is no exception coming from vines over 100 years old. Bursting with notes of ripe cranberries and pomegranate and bunches of wild herbs, this Pais is a fantastic representation of the grapes light body and crunchy minerality.

Barbera is not often grown in Argentina so this wine is a rare treat. Full of blackberry and boysenberry fruit leading to notes of rose petals and tobacco, this is a fuller bodied expression of Barbera with a juicy finish and fine, medium tannins.
