#### FRANÇOIS CHIDAINE, 2020, ROUGE, TOURAINE, LOIRE VALLEY

While winemaker François Chidaine has been known for years as being a driving force in bringing biodynamic and organic growing practices to his region of Montlouis, he more recently started this project of younger vine plantings in the neighboring AOC of Touraine. We love them as they offer a great price to quality ratio. Composed of equal parts \Côt (the Loire term for Malbec), Cabernet Franc, and the rare local varietal Pineau D'Aunis, this wine is fermented and aged in 100% stainless steel to keep the fruit and minerality bright and fresh. We recommend letting this wine breath for an hour or, better yet, decanting as it is young.

### GRANGE SAINT-SAUVEUR, 2018, ROUGE, VIN DE FRANCE, LOIRE VALLEY

Winemaker Antoine Pouponneau's name may not be familiar to most, but his hands have helped to craft some spectacular wines from the likes of La Tour du Bon in Bandol, Clos Canarelli in Corsica, as well as both Cheval Blanc and Latour in Bordeaux.

Grange Saint-Sauveur represents Antione's and his wife Alice Gitton-Pouponneau's (a graduate in Enology with a focus on natural methods) first foray into owning and hand farming their own vineyards under their own label based in Anjou, Loire Valley.

Made from a blend of 40 plus year old vines planted to Grolleau (a local specialty of the Anjou AOC) and Cabernet Franc, this new project by an incredibly talented team is sure to raise interest in the wine world in the coming vintages.
