1. BIDAIA 2021 TXAKOLINA ROSÉ, GETARIAKO, SPAIN

AHI POKE - LOTUS ROOT CHIP AND SOY GINGER SAUCE

Made from a blend of two varietals distinct to the region, Hondarrabi Beltza and Hondarrabi Zuri, this light, refreshing, high acid Rosé with a slight spritz from the Basque region of Spain is one of our favorite go-to's for a Summer sipper.

2. DOMAINE LES GRYPHEÉS 2020 GAMAY, FLEURIE, BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE

YELLOW CURRY - POTATO, DAIKON RADISH, MUSHROOM

With bright notes of strawberry jam and rose petals, this wine also expresses a deep core of granite minerality alongside a streak of refreshing acidity. Try serving this Gamay with just a slight chill to make it extra refreshing.

3. DOMAINE ANITA 2020 "REINE DE NUIT," MOULIN-À-VENT, BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE

SURVEYOR RED

YELLOW CURRY - POTATO, DAIKON RADISH, MUSHROOM

Darker in profile than it's counterpart in the Fleurie, this Gamay displays notes of blueberry compote, baking spice, and finishes with juicy black cherry tempered with bright citric acid. Once again, a slight chill is recommended.

4. CHATEAU CANADEL 2017 MOURVÈDRE BLEND, BANDOL, FRANCE

BAO BUN - KOREAN BULGOGI WITH PICKLED RADISH, CARROT, ONION, AND PEA SHOOTS

From the town that is largely considered the crown jewel of Provence in the south of France comes this stunner of a deep, earthy Red blend composed of 70% Mourvèdre, 22% Cinsault, 5% Grenache, and 3% Syrah from vines planted in 1978. With notes of brambly blackberry, roasted fennel, and asphalt, this wine is sure to develop nicely over the next decade but is showing incredibly well now after some time spent in a decanter.
