1. MASSERIA FURFANTE 2021 BOMBINO BIANCO, PUGLIA, ITALY

SCALLOPED POTATOES WITH PAN SEARED RAINBOW TROUT

This crisp, clean white wine comes from one of the most Southern regions of Italy. With notes of Meyer Lemon, Cantaloupe, and an oceanic minerality, this is a great Spring and Summertime sipper for all types of seafood especially when enjoyed at the beach or by a river.

2. DOMAINE MUCYN 2016 'GAMSY', VIN DE PAYS DES COLLINES RHODANIENNES, FRANCE

BOAR'S HEAD HOT DOG ON A BRIOCHE BUN WITH TOMATO BACON JAM

Made from a blend of 60% Syrah and 40% Gamay, this older vintage wine is currently showing fantastically well! Deep, earthy notes and smoke are perfectly balanced on a light, bright frame alongside ripe fruit.

3. DOMAINE MUCYN 2020 " LES ENTRECŒURS," CROZES HERMITAGE, FRANCE

BOAR'S HEAD HOT DOG ON A BRIOCHE BUN WITH TOMATO BACON JAM

This 100% Syrah from 40 year old vines is a text book example from the Northern Rhône valley of France. Rich notes of dark cherry gracefully intertwine with camp fire and herbaceous hints of lavender followed by long, silky tannins and a bit of wild sage making it the perfect wine to crack open on a night in the desert.

4. LOPEZ DE HEREDIA 2011 "VIÑA BOSCONIA," RIOJA, SPAIN

SMOKED TRI TIP CHILI WITH A CHEDDAR JALAPEÑO CORN MUFFIN

Founded in 1877, Lopez De Heredia is regarded as a benchmark for quality wines from Rioja. The 2011 Bosconia is soft and supple with notes of tart cherry, plum, and figs all deftly balanced against oak and olive tapenade. It's the ideal wine to break out for dinner after a long day of hiking in the mountains.
